Policy # 19 – Shooter Eviction

The Range Manager and on-duty Range Officers have the authority to evict anyone from RSSC property who exhibit behaviors that affect the safety of others and/or the smooth operation of the facility.

Procedure # 19 - Shooter Eviction

01/31/2018

The following 6 behaviors that may result in requesting that a shooter, member or guest leave the range:

- 1. Gun handling during a cease fire.
- 2. Pointing a gun at anyone, loaded or unloaded, inadvertently or otherwise.
- 3. Firing the gun after declaration of cease fire. Judgement to be used to determine if the firing was intentional or so close to the declaration as to be unavoidable. Corrections (up to 2) to be issued prior to ejection.
- 4. Excessive Foul language.
- 5. Verbal abuse directed at fellow shooters or Range employees.
- 6. Aggressive or intimidating behavior directed at fellow shooters or Range employees.

Per existing range rules, shooters will follow directions given by range officers. All decisions to issue corrections or ask that shooters leave the facility are at the discretion of the Range Officer and/or their supervision.
