

Rio Salado Sportsman's Club, Inc. Policies and Procedures

Policy # 07 – Free Shooting at the Public Range:

The Rio Salado Sportsman's Club encourages range use, and membership in the Club. To that end, members of the Board of Directors, including the Executive Board, are authorized to distribute <u>two</u> free passes per month to individuals who they believe are new to shooting or to the range.

Procedures - Free Shooting at the Public Range

The pass can be obtained from the Range Manager's office in the Activity Center. The Board Member giving out the pass will sign and date the pass; otherwise the pass will be considered invalid.

Pass users will hand them to the Range Safety Officer when checking in at the Public Range. Passes are good ONLY at the Public Range. A pass is good only for one individual, only for one month from date signed by the Board Member, and should not be given to the same individual more than once.

The Range Manager or Chief Range Safety Officer may issue passes as a reward or "rain check" to certain individuals under extenuating circumstances, at their discretion.
